

**Automatic Recount Meeting of the May 6, 2014 Primary Election
Republican Central Committee Member
Union Township U1U**

Chairman Tim Rudd called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

OTHER ATTENDEES: Jared Martin-Candidate-arrived at 10:15 a.m. and Andrew Williams – SOS Liaison-arrived at 10:53 a.m.

Instructions to Observers:

At the opening of the meeting there were no Observers or Candidates. Judy did state that Carol Addie Keim and Judith Kelch signed waivers to receive the certified notices (of the recount meeting) by regular mail. She was unable to contact Jared Martin; therefore he was notified of the Recount by certified mail.

TEST DECK:

The Board went off the record at 10:01 a.m. to run the Test Deck.

The Board went back on the record at 10:15 a.m.

Judy explained that the test deck consisted of UN-U1U only. Tim read from the control sheet while Dave compared the results on the newly run test deck and found them to match and that the computer was counting accurately.

2014-64 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the results of the Recount Test Deck. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Jared Martin entered the meeting at 10:15 a.m. Judy gave him the instructions on being an observer, the hand count procedures and how he became the declared winner.

2014-65 – Rick Combs made the motion for the Board to delegate the hand counting of the ballots in UN-U1U to the staff. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

The Board went off the record at 10:19 a.m. for the hand count.

The Board went back on the record at 10:36 a.m.

The Results of the Hand Count were as follows, which is the same as the Official Certified Results:

Keim - 18 votes Kelch - 9 votes Martin -18 votes over votes - 0 votes under votes - 6 votes

Total votes = 44

2014-66 – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the Results of the Hand Count for UN-U1U. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

The Board went off the record at 10:37 a.m. to run the ballots thru the 650 scanner.

The Board went back on the record at 10:40 a.m.

The Results of the UN-U1U ballots that were run thru the scanner were as follows:

Keim - 18 votes Kelch - 9 votes Martin -18 votes over votes - 0 votes under votes - 6 votes

Total votes = 44

2014-67 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the results of the Tabulated Ballots and that they match the Hand Count. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

The winner is Jared T. Martin as determined during Certification by lot.

The Board went off the Record at 10:40 a.m. to run the Test Deck.

The Board went back on the Record at 10:55 a.m.

Tim read from the control sheet while Dave compared the results on the newly run test deck and found them to match and that the computer was counting accurately.

2014-68 – Rick Combs made the motion to Verify and Accept the Results of the Test Deck. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Judy discussed the upcoming DIMS Conference with the Board. The Board had allowed up to five staff to attend. After the schedule came out she contacted DIMS and then decided that not everyone needs to attend. Several new topics include 1) Change of address 2) Inputting information for the homeless 3) Additional fields for military and civilian overseas addresses. There are a few other topics such as Crystal Reports that are beneficial to an IT person. The Board advised they stand by their previous motion to allow the Director and Deputy Director to select the staff members needing to attend the DIMS Conference.

Judy gave the Board a handout on Employee Salaries and Tim suggested that they discuss it at the next meeting. Judy added that it has been about two months since the letter regarding “employee raises” was sent to the Commissioners and she has not received a response back. Starting a week ago she tried to contact Steve Rabolt and again has had no response to the letter.
